# MATERIALS

# MEXICAN TILES QUILT FEATURING MOODY BLUES BY GENINNE

Note: Some fabrics in this collection are directional fabric. Read all instructions before starting the project.

Fat Quarters each:

Perched Birds

Flora [White]

Cacti

Blooms

Pomegranate Bird

Butterflies [Navy]

Butterflies [White]

Mosaic

Floral [Navy]

Sashiko Bird

Sashiko Trees

from Cirrus Solids: Dots

Ocean

Lava

Turquoise

Fat Quarters each

1 yard Limestone for Background 1/2 yard Ocean for Binding 3½ yards Mosaic for Backing

Note: All possible care has been taken to assure the accuracy of this pattern. We are not responsible for printing errors or the manner in which individual work varies. Please read instructions carefully before starting the construction of this quilt. If desired, wash and iron your fabrics before starting to cut.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include 1/4" seam allowances. From various prints:

48-8" squares:

- 4 from each: Pomegranate Bird, Sashiko Bird, Butterflies [Navy], Blooms, & Turquoise
- 3 from each: Perched Birds, Butterflies [White], Mosaic, Floral [Navy], Dots, Sashiko Trees, Lava, and Ocean
- 2 from each: Cacti, Floral [White]

*From* Limestone:

12- 2½" x WOF strips subcut into:

• 192- 2½" squares

# ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of all 21/2" squares. [fig 1]
- 2. Place a marked 2½" square in corners of each 8" square right sides together. Sew along diagonal lines. [fig 2]
- 3. Fold up inner triangle of the marked square toward each corner and press. Trim the bottom two layers 1/4" from seam line. Repeat for all marked squares. [fig 3]

# **ASSEMBLING THE QUILT**

- 4. Layout blocks in rows following the **QUILT DIAGRAM** for placement.
- 5. Sew blocks in rows pressing each row in opposite directions.
- 6. Sew 8 rows together to complete quilt top.
- 7. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
